- As an assiduous collaborator with the Town of Buena Vista, we share the Town's vision of economic vitality. **3 3** 









2021 <u>Jet / Turbine</u> aircraft: 466 = **106 gal / AC** 


2021 <u>Piston</u> aircraft: 1,320 = <u>11 gal / AC</u>


